Progression Policy

The entry to different levels in English will be based initially on scores on an English Entry Test. Students who score between 0 < -60% will be placed in **English Level 1**. Those who score between 60% < -75% will be eligible to study at **English Level 2** and 75% < -85% and above will directly go to **English Level 3** above 85% student is exempted.

The progression requirement from one level to the other will be a pass in the course at each level. In case of failing a level, the student will have to repeat that level once. Overall, it is mandatory for students to pass English Levels 1, 2 and 3, Levels 2 and 3 or Level 3 based on their placement score in the respective levels. Students placed directly in Level 3 (based on placement test score) should take IT 1 and Maths 1 subjects. If s/he passed level 3 s/he must complete the IT 2 and Maths 2 courses in the following trimester (i.e. Trimester 2) and during 2 which, they may be given the option to take some College Required Courses or Electives of their disciplines. If students obtained Academic IELTS with score band of 5 before the end of the GFP then s/he may join the speciality programme in September and complete level 2 of Math and IT as well.

Students who obtain band 5 in Academic IELTS from external recognised IELTS centres are exempted from English subject. Students who scores >85% in Math challenge test is exempted from Math and those who obtain IC3 or ICDL are exempted from Information Technology.

Mathematics and IT courses are not offered with English Level 1.

Students who passe all the three levels of English, two levels of Math and two levels of IT pass the GFP and are awarded with an GFP Pass Certificate

Students could finish GFP in two years provided s/he did not fail the same level twice.

Students who fail a level (either English, Math or IT) twice will be dismissed
